St. Martin's is registered with the Charity Commission and is a non-profit making organization. A Board of Trustees is responsible for the professional and dedicated staff who manage the residence. The Home is registered with Social Services and is a member of South East Essex Care Homes Association .

St. Martin's aims to provide a quality care home for elderly people with the principle aims of meeting the individual needs of all residents whilst complying with the National Care Standards. Residents are encouraged to enhance their rooms with their own small items of furniture, pictures, ornaments, etc. Relatives and residents are actively encouraged to give their views on the running of the home. Visitors are welcome any time.
